

Job Opportunity: Part-Time Research Assistant at the Ji Lab, Stanford University School of Medicine

The Ji Lab at the Stanford University School of Medicine is seeking a motivated part-time research assistant to support ongoing clinical cancer genomics studies. This role is set to begin in Fall 2024 and offer opportunities for professional growth.

Responsibilities:

- Collect and manage clinical samples/specimens according to SOPs; recruit participants for a research study.
- Perform experiments in support of research projects such as extracting nucleic acids and preparing sequencing libraries.
